ARENAS AND FOOTING: Dressage tests will be ridden in an indoor arena, all before noon (12pm). Jumping courses and equitation/ group classes will be in the outdoor arenas.

DIRECTIONS: 208 Shannon Trails, Salem NH 03079

From Rte 495 North: Take 495 North to exit 108, turn left onto RT 97 n/ Broadway. Continue to follow MA-97 N (entering NH) at lights turn right on Hampstead Road, this will turn into Shannon Road. Continue on for about 2.2 miles, Shannon Trails will be on the right .

From Rte 93 North: Take 93 North to exit 2 (RT97). Stay straight on Main ST (RT97) for about 6.2 miles. At lights turn left onto Hampstead Road, this will turn into Shannon Road. Continue on for about 2.2 miles, Shannon Trails will be on the right .

GENERAL INFORMATION

This competition is run in accordance with current USEF rules. Appropriate dress for horse and rider is mandated by USEF rules, Sections DR120 and DR121

- ASTM Protective headgear must be worn at all times when mounted.
- Please ride and lunge only in designated areas.
